## Can I apply?

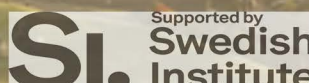
### You can apply if you:

- Are a citizen of or resident in one of the following countries: Armenia, Azerbaijan\*, Belarus\*, Georgia\*, Moldova, Ukraine
- Have a good command of English, both spoken and written
- Have a relevant higher education (at least three years of study)
- Are between 25 – 40 (born 1985 – 2000)
- Are currently employed in one of the following groups:
  1. Policymakers (politicians, government officials, employees of political parties)
  2. Public servants (non-political civil servants working at public organisations)
  3. Civil society workers (CSO/NGO employees)
  4. Leaders within the private sector
- Have the mandate, ambition and potential to drive change within your organisation and home country
- Your professional profile is relevant for the thematic content of the module of your choice
